***Last Comic Standing* Finalist & Veteran Funny Man**  
**Gary Gulman**  
**at the Stroum Jewish Community Center on Thursday,**  
**December 1**  
**\*\*ONE NIGHT ONLY\*\***

SEATTLE, WA – October 20, 2016 – On Thursday, December 1, *Last Comic Standing* finalist and *Inside Amy Schumer* alumnus, comedian Gary Gulman, returns to Seattle for an exclusive, one-night-only appearance at the Stroum Jewish Community Center. Tickets to this event, rescheduled from earlier in 2016, will be offered to those who purchased tickets for Gulman's February 18 performance, which was cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances.

Blending endearing self-deprecation with warm amusement at everyday experience, Gulman is among only a few comedians to have appeared on every single late-night comedy program. He appeared with Dane Cook, Jay Davis, and Robert Kelly on Dane Cook's 2005 *Tourgasm* and hosted the final season of *Comedy All-Stars* on New England Sports Network. Gulman has tickled thousands with two one-hour Comedy Central specials; his 20th anniversary tour, the "It's About Time Tour," wrapped up earlier this year after selling out theaters across the country.

The hilarious Gulman had a small but memorable role in Megan Griffiths's 2013 film, *LUCKY THEM*, portraying the charming Craig, lovable groomsman and aspiring psychotherapist. *LUCKY THEM* was shot on location in and around Seattle.

Gulman brings his wry observations and semi-serious deadpan wit to the SJCC's 358-seat Cultural Arts venue on Mercer Island, which is in its second season of programming after renovating their beautiful theatre with luxurious seating, and state-of-the-art Dolby Digital sound following an extensive renovation. Gulman's performance begins at 8:00 PM; doors open at 7:00 PM for a pre-show happy hour (cash bar). Tickets are \$25, or \$20 for seniors, students, youth, and SJCC members.
