As a Youth Soccer Official, you are responsible for player safety, understanding and implementing the league rules, and maintaining the flow of the game.

Some of the duties and responsibilities of a Youth Soccer Official are to:

- Act as a representative of the SJCC; presenting with professionalism, reliability, and a clear understanding of the league and rules.
- Assist with field set up and tear down.
- Manage game play and prioritize player safety.
- Provide small and brief coaching points to the kids during game play to help develop them as players.
- Communicate with the Youth Sports & Recreation Manager about any concerns, issues, or scheduling conflicts.
- Be consistent and present on time every week.

The schedule requirements are to:

- Be present for weekly games from 1-4pm.
- Complete all mandatory referee meetings and trainings

To be successful as a Youth Soccer Official, you should have:

- A passion for soccer and a good knowledge of the game and rules.
- A high level of professionalism and integrity.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
- The ability to resolve conflicts.
- The ability to move around the field.
- The ability to see and hear around the field.
- A CPR certification which can be provided by the SJCC.

Compensation and Benefits Include:

- Community Center Membership (single adult membership).
- Paid sick leave (1 hour of sick leave accrued for every 40 hours of work.)

- Washington State Pay Range: \$15/hr to \$16/hr.
